Countries with declining birthrates are mostly concerned about this for economic reasons. As the population grows older and retires, there will be stress on the pension system. Ideally, many young people need to work to pay taxes for older people to get retirement benefits. If there are more retired people than workers, then the system will break down.

The American solution to this problem is to allow many immigrant workers into their country. If Americans did not allow 1 million immigrants a year into the US, they would have the same economic problems as other countries with aging populations.

But is that the right solution? The planet has never had so many people. There are food and water shortages in many areas. Much-needed forests are being destroyed to make room for more and more people. It would seem then that the real solution is to have less children in the future.

The world has limited resources and the more people there are, the more the natural resources are strained. Human population growth has devastated the animal kingdom. Animals are going extinct every single day. Industry is polluting the air and leading to climate change. The only way to save the planet may reduce the number of people before it is too late.
